be from one living person to another living person. However
transferee need not be a competent person like transferor. A
transferee may be a minor, insane or child in mother's womb.

transfer of property. According to this section, transfer of property
means an act by which a living person conveys property, in present or
in future, to one or more other living persons, or to himself and
other living persons.

However, when in a transfer of property, if the direction is that if the right of enjoyment is to terminate only on the death of the transferor, the transfer does not create a vested interest. In *Kokilambal v. N Raman Kokilambal 3*, there was a deed of family settlement in which the settlor created a limited interest (right to receive the income from rents).

You must pay the Real Property Transfer Tax (RPTT) on sales, grants, assignments, transfers or surrenders of real property in New York City. You must also pay RPTT for the sale or transfer of at least 50% of ownership in a corporation, partnership, trust, or other entity that owns/leases property and transfers of cooperative housing stock shares.
